Business

- Tony Curtis averages 100 public appearances per year.
- TonyCurtis.com receives over 230,000 hits per month.

Entertainment Career

- The Tony Curtis filmography consists of over 130 films including: *The Prince Who Was a Thief, Flesh and Fury, No Room for the Groom, Houdini, Johnny Dark, Trapeze, The Sweet Smell of Success, The Vikings, The Defiant Ones, Some Like it Hot, Operation Petticoat, Who Was That Lady?, Spartacus, The Great Imposter, Wild and Wonderful, The Great Race, Boeing Boeing* and *The Boston Strangler*.
- The film *Some Like it Hot* was named by the American Film Institute as the funniest movie of the past 100 years.
- Tony Curtis was nominated for a Best Actor Academy Award for his work in the film *The Defiant Ones*.
- Tony Curtis appears on the cover of The Beatles’ *Sgt. Pepper’s Lonely Hearts Club Band*.
- Tony Curtis was the inspiration for, and voice of, the Flintstones’ character “Stoney Curtis.”
- Curtis starred in numerous television series in the 1970’s including *The Persuaders* with Roger Moore, *McCoy* and *Vega\$*.
- In 1976, Curtis published the novel titled *Kid Cody and Julie Sparrow*.

Art Career

- Tony Curtis has been painting since the early 1960’s and drawing since childhood.
- The Tony Curtis art archive includes over 250 original works with Curtis creating an average of 75 new pieces each year.
- Tony Curtis’s art is included in the permanent collection of New York’s Museum of Modern Art.
- Tony Curtis’s artwork averages yearly dollar sales of \$1,000,000.
- Curtis’s art is in the private collections of Billy Wilder, California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger, Frank Sinatra, Arsenio Hall, Lew Wasserman, Burt Lancaster and Kirk Douglas.

Personal

- Tony Curtis was born June 3, 1925 in Bronx, NY.
- Curtis served in the Navy, on a submarine, during WWII and was injured while battling in Guam.
- Tony Curtis was recently made an honorary Admiral, one of the Navy’s highest honors.

Philanthropy

- Curtis, with his wife Jill, cofounded the highly respected Shiloh Horse Rescue and Sanctuary. A portion of sales from the Cats Helping Horses art collection go directly to this non-profit organization. Tony and Jill are frequent visitors to the Shiloh ranch.
- Shiloh Horse Rescue and Sanctuary has rescued and rehabilitated over 400 hundred horses (and even a few pigs, sheep, chickens, llamas, donkeys and goats).
- Shiloh Horse Rescue and Sanctuary is located on 40 acres in Sandy Valley, Nevada.
